Presentation

Web-based learning refers to the type of learning that uses the Internet as an instructional delivery tool to carry out various learning activities. It can take the form of purely online learning in which the curriculum and learning are implemented online without a face-to-face meeting between the instructor and the students, or a hybrid in which the instructor meets the students half of the time online and half of the time in the classroom, depending on the needs and requirement of the curriculum.

Objectives

The advance of online technology and instructional delivery such as Web-based learning (WBL) has heralded new changes in education. Results showed that five main factors influence the effectiveness of the online learning process: 1) students' behaviour 2) characteristics of lecturers 3) interactive application 4) technology and 5) the institutions.

The objective of the training course is to help educators understand the advance of online technology and instructional delivery such as Web-based learning (WBL).

The training course provides the participants with the necessary skills to:

- Digital learning awareness
- Defining ICT usage in adult education with its benefits, provide educators with practical ideas for how they can incorporate technology into their existing lessons.
- Exchanging experiences in the cooperative and collaborative learning process if in creativity and innovation
- Sharing of best practice in teaching and learning, using ICT.
